NEWS FROM THE PATIENT PARTICIPATION GROUP (PPG)

The times, they are a'changin'......and in the world that is our Old Court House (OCH) Surgery that is so true.

Some 'routine' tasks within the surgery are being automated.....but fear thee not, it is all for the betterment of the excellent service we are already used to at OCH.

Some 'lab test results' will be automatically processed, and those patients who already have a digital connection to the surgery should have been made aware.

The 'new patient' registration process will also become automated.

Access to the surgery is now easier, in that there will no longer be a request 'to 'phone back tomorrow'. Instead, you can be directed to the website, to then complete an online 'triage and help' form. While promoting digital communication is efficient, the surgery will make provision for those patients without access to a computer, tablet or mobile phone.

But that is not alla big, very welcome change is that the new telephone system for OCH Surgery is 'live'.....which allows the patient to request a 'call back'.....and we know that this does work!

To illustrate the effectiveness of the new telephone system, perhaps the statistics from just one random day's telephone records, as follows, will do just that:-

The NHS App

The NHS App is safe and secure. If you're aged 16 and over, you can register for the NHS App without visiting the Practice. It is a simple and secure way to access a range of services on your smartphone or tablet and is free from app stores. The NHS App is also available on the OCH website.

It can be used to conveniently:

- Book and cancel appointments
- Order repeat medication
- View your health record including consultations, diagnosis, documents and results of tests or investigations
- view your Covid vaccination status
- check your symptoms using reliable NHS information on hundreds of conditions and treatments
- register to be an organ donor
- choose how the NHS uses your data
- The NHS App should not be confused with the NHS COVID-19 App.
