NEWS FROM THE PATIENT Participation group (PPG)

This Newsletter comes to you after a very eventful time.....the sad loss of our Beloved Majesty, political upheaval, the energy crisis, as well as an unprecedented heatwave.....and hopefully, the lessening of the dreaded Covid!

Also eventful.....the publication of a nationwide survey by our NHS – Patient Experiences. In all, 18 questions were asked of a very small, random sample of patients.....which averaged about 1% of the possible total. Whilst many of the questions could have been better, or more clearly worded, we are pleased to note and advise that OCH scored better on the vast majority of the questions, than the local, South West London, and the National responses.

One question related to 'Patients seeing their preferred GP'......well, as advised previously, with our OCH system, after a brief discussion when you call for an appointment, our staff will ensure that you see the most appropriate professional. Thanks to your PPG, the OCH surgery now has improved its internal signage. For those patients with mobility, hearing or sight issues, the nurse / GP will ensure you are 'collected' when your appointment is called.
